

Location



The Youth Exhange activities and the accomodation will be at the beautiful **Perma Haloş in Romania**.

Located in the remote area of Manastirea Casin commune, by the river Haloş, surrounded by hills and forests, Perma Halos is giving space for the young people to develop and implement activities linked to environmental awareness, permaculture, and serves as an ever-growing socio- cultural and educational center since 2020.

Zero Waste: Most of the buildings are built by hand with natural materials. Recycling (plastic, glass, paper) is in place and organic materials are composted for natural fertilizer to the garden.



Accommodation



Accommodation in Perma Halos is mixed indoors and outdoors:

- guesthouse: 20 single beds and all the basic standards
- activity room dormitory: 10 single beds
- glamping tents: 4-4 pallet beds each and several regular tents with matraces and sleeping bags
- 1 indoor and several outdoor showers and toilets

Participants will be provided with towels and bed linen.

Washing machine and hairdryers will be available for shared use.



Food



The food is mainly vegetarian, because of the sustainability focus of the venue, however, all 3 meals includes every kind of food group like vegetables, eggs, fruits, legumes, dairy, bread with all the essential nutrients.

We take into consideration any specific diets or food intolerances of the participants.

We aim to provide local, handmade and home-grown products as much as possible.

The covered travel expenses **up to the maximum** indicated sums per person.


Traveling reimbursement
